Membership Statement:

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes

Safe Sport Reminder:

Reminder: All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. Motorized Vehicle Statement:

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed “unsafe use” if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

Stalls: Excellent permanent box stalls are available. All stalls have doors. Available after at 10AM Wednesday, July 24, early entry available Tuesday after 5PM for \$25 per stall.

TBA Class Policy: To add a class, call Tricia Hoen. All classes: \$60. No paybacks will be offered. Limited availability.

Bedding: All bedding needs to be purchased through the show with a 2 bag minimum. A fee of \$50 will be charged for any participant using outside bedding by Minnesota Equestrian Center (MEC).

Credit Policy: If there is a history of returned checks with an trainer(s)/exhibitor(s), the exhibitor will be required to remit payment for any current and future show fees in the form of cash, cashier's check or certified check to the North Star Horse Show. The exhibitor must pay for the open balance prior to the start of the show in order to participate at the show. Cash will only be accepted at the end of the show to close out the account.

Refunds: Full refunds will be made only when a veterinary's certificate is presented before the start of the show. Refunds for entry fees only will be made when said certificate is received after the start of the show. Once the horse is on the show grounds, ONLY the official show veterinarian may issue said certificate.

Scratches: Exhibitors must notify the show office of scratches, one hour before each session. Scratches for medical reasons must present a doctor/Veterinarian certificate to show office for refunds.

Horse Show Office Hours: The horse show office will close one hour before each performance. Entries for classes within a performance should be made prior to that closing. Check posted hours for additional closings.

Rules and Regulations

Coggins: All horses must present proof a negative Coggins test within the past 12 months.

Out of State Horses: must present a vet issued health certificate within the past 30 days.

Medical Waste: There will be at least one sharps container per 50 occupied stalls for disposal of needles and other disposable sharp instruments in convenient locations in the barns. Competition management may fine any individuals including trainers, owners, exhibitors or their agents up to \$100 for improper disposal of medical waste.

- Dogs must be on leashes at all times or in tack stalls and tied away from doorways.

Show Definitions

Academy classes: will begin 1 hour after the end of the performance classes on Friday and Saturday but not start before noon. Open to saddle seat, hunt seat and western riders who have not competed in regular competition classes. Walk/Trot riders may not compete in any class that canters. Attire of dark pants, jodhpurs or breeches. Shoes with heels or boots, dress shirt, tie, sweater or seater vest. No fitted vests or coats. No derbies, western hats. Safety helmets are permitted and encouraged. Rider only to be judged. Open to any suitable horse or pony with suitable tack.

AMHA Medal classes: All AMHA Medal Classes will be judged based on the specifications outlined in rules MO165, MO168 - MO173. Silver Medal winners in any seat who have won a single rider class may compete in one (1) other AMHA medal class with multiple riders (they are not eligible to participate in another single entry class); however, they will not be awarded a second medal should they be the class winner, except in Dressage Seat where qualifiers may ride, but will not be considered for placing. Any rider who competes in a class of 2 or more and wins and receives the medal is no longer eligible to compete in Medal classes in that seat for the remainder of the qualifying year.

Amateur Owned, Trained and Shown (AOTS): TO be eligible for these classes, horses must not have been in training with a professional barn after January 1 of the current year. Rider/Driver need not be the owner.

Championship Eligibility: To be eligible to compete in a divisional championship, a horse must have been shown and judged in one other class in that division.

Championship Classes: Will not be stripped.

Helmets: Leadline entrants must wear protective headgear at all times while mounted.

Junior Exhibitor: The age of the junior exhibitor as of December 1, of the year prior shall be maintained throughout the entire show year. A junior exhibitor is 17 years and under. Protective headgear is acceptable.

Junior Horse: Is a horse 4 years old and under as of January 1 of the current year.

Ladies Classes: Open to ladies age 18 and older

Limit: A horse that has not yet won 6 firsts in an USEF rated show in that division prior to the closing date of the show.

Masters: Open to amateur riders/drivers 50 years old and older.

Stallions: No stallions may be entered in classes which specify ladies or junior exhibitor to ride or drive, including Fitting and Showmanship.

Walk-Trot/Jog Exhibitors: Open to riders who are 12 years old and younger. To be judged on the rail at the walk and trot/jog only. Rider must not have been judged in ANY saddle class, test or pattern that has required a canter/lope in a recognized or non-recognized competition. Riders may not enter any other class in the competition in which they are competing with the exception of other walk and trot classes, driving, fitting and showmanship, judging team competitions and specialty classes such as costume and other non-canter event, etc. Competitions are encouraged to divide the walk and trot divisions by age and seat. Stallions are prohibited. Equipment, attire and presentation must match the discipline being ridden and the class entered. Protective headgear is acceptable. Horses must not be asked to back. Before horses are judged in the lineup, on attendant without whip, per entry will be permitted in the lineup and will be called in by the announce.

Ride a \$5: Enter on entry form. Horse will be ridden bareback with any kind of bridle. Ringmaster will place your \$5 bill under your left leg as you enter the ring. The judge will call the required gaits. When your \$5 falls to the ground you will ride to the center of the ring and line up. The last rider to have the \$5 under their leg will take the pot.

Concurrent Classes: Classes will be run concurrently but pinned separately. If there are more than 6 entries in either division, they will be run separately but consecutively.

Single Bit Open Breed Pleasure Division: Single Bit class is to Amateur/Juvenile riders, in a snaffle bit only (no curb bits or curb chains allowed), with a running martingale, German martingale or draw rein. All tack should be of show quality. Riders are to wear appropriate show ring attire. Horse/rider combinations may not cross enter into another division.

A. RULES AND REGULATIONS: I hereby agree that I have read, understand, and agree to be bound by all applicable Federation Bylaws, rules, and policies including the USEF Safe Sport Policy and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies (MAAPP) as published at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time.

B. 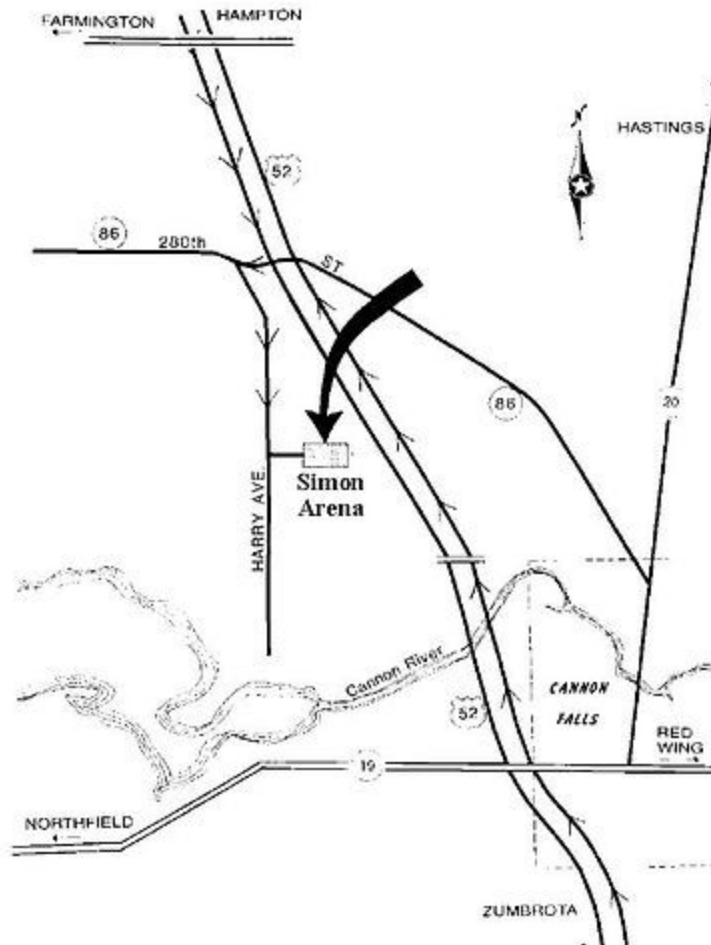
